VOIVODESHIP OF LODZ

- It covers an area of 18,218.95 km².
- One of the 16 voivodeships of Poland.
- Located in the central part of the country.
- In 2020, 2.4 mln people were recorded here.
- Lodz is the most important city in our region.
- Important ci<mark>ties: Łódź, Piotrków Trybunalski, Pabianice, Tomaszów Mazowiecki.</mark>





LODZ

- Lodz is the third city in Poland in terms of population.
- It was granted city rights in 1423.
- Hanna Zdanowska is the president of Lodz.













LOWICZ

- Lowicz is very associated with regional traditions and costumes.
- Established in 1136, town rights in 1298.
- The mayor or Lowicz is Krzysztof Kalinski.

























GLOWNO

- Established in 15th century, town rights 1427-1869, 1925.
- Mayor of Glowno Grzegorz Janeczek.
- Glowno is divided into districts.
- The local football team is Stal Glowno.


- The country with the first constitution in Europe, the second in the World.

- Moving capital of Poland.














- The Polish stadium can accommodate around 60,000 people and is the largest stadium in Poland.


